Daniel Aebly, Aged, 74, Monroe, Dies: Rites Wednesday

Funeral services for Daniel Aebly, 74 years of age, 605 22nd Ave., Monroe, a resident of the Monticello area of many years, who passed away as the result of old age complications at 8:20 Monday morning in the Masshardt nursing home, Monroe, were held at 2:30 Wednesday afternoon in the Voegeli funeral home here.

Mr. David Hilsey, Dubuque, Iowa, a representative of the Watch Tower organization, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery here.

Mr. Aebly had been in failing health for several years.

Native of Switzerland

A native of Switzerland, Mr. Aebly was born in Canton Glarus, Sept. 17,1878, the son of Melchior and Barbara Jenny Aebly. He came to America in March, 1881, with his parents, the family settling in Green county. Mr. Aebly had always made his home with a sister, Mrs. Robert Blum, Washington township, and moved to Monroe with them seven years ago.
