

Jacob Altmann Jr.
1902 - Sept. 1936

Monroe — After hanging undiscovered for nearly three weeks, the body of Jacob Altmann, 34, Monroe farmer, was found in the top of a barn on a farm he owns at the east edge of the city Wednesday afternoon. Coroner Frank A. Shriner said that it was an obvious case of suicide, and will hold no inquest.

Funeral services were held at 3 p. m. Thursday, and burial was in Monticello cemetery.

Altmann had been sought since he disappeared from his home at noon on Sunday, Sept. 27. After putting his car in a barn at the home of his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jacob Altmann Sr., he was seen to cross the road to a farm he owned, occupied by his brother, Theodore. No trace of him was found after that time, and county officials had conducted an open search for him in the vicinity recently, after the disappearance had been quietly investigated for a few days.

Survivors are his parents, four brothers and two sisters.
