Rites Held Sunday For Herman Amstutz Former Local Man Dies Friday in Monroe at Age of 51

Funeral services for Herman Amstutz, 51 years of age, a former Monticello resident, who passed away Friday at a Monroe convalescent home where he had been a resident for the past two years, were conducted at 2 Sunday afternoon in the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Herman Amstutz was born in Argyle Aug. 4, 1895, the son of Sam and Maria Welch Amstutz. Thirty-five years ago he moved to Monticello with his parents, who for many years owned and operated the Grand Central hotel here. After the death of his mother in 1939, he was a patient at the Deaconess hospital, Monroe, and later at the convalescent home, Mr. Amstutz had been in ill health since 1929. Before entering the convalescent home in which he died, Mr. Amstutz had received care at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Blum, both here and when they resided in Monroe.

Survivors include two brothers, Walter, Monticello, and William, Monroe; and two sisters, Mrs. Anna Stauffacher, Monticello, and Mrs. Henry Marty, Appleton.
