Dewey o. Anderson, 72, Dies Suddenly in Hospital Saturday

Funeral services for Dewey O. Anderson, 72 years of age, esteemed Monticello resident, who died unexpectedly at 4:55 Saturday afternoon in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

The Rev. Joshua L. Crowell, pastor of the Evansville Congregational United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Edwin Affolter, Racine. John Affolter, Joseph Jones. Leroy Peterson, Juda, Paul Affolter, Monroe, and Robert Klechner, McConnell, Ill.

Mr. Anderson had been a surgical patient at the hospital since Oct. 6 and had been reported as doing well following the surgery.

He was born at Webb, Iowa, on Aug. 15, 1898, the son of Olus and Bertha Matheson Anderson. He moved to Beloit with his family as a small child and graduated from high school there. He farmed in the Beloit area until 1949 and since 1955 had worked in Monticello and Monroe.

On Sept. 17, 1955, he was united in marriage to Gertrude Schmid by the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, and had since resided in Monticello.

He is survived by his wife; a son, Calvin Anderson, Evansville; a daughter, Mrs. Leon Patterson, Appleton; step-sons, Eugene Schmid, Beloit, and T/Sgt. John A. Schmid, Robbins AFB, Georgia; one sister, Mrs. Leo Lynch, Beloit, and 10 grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by two sisters and five brothers.
