Alma L. Arn, age 94, of Monticello, died Saturday, September 8, 2007 at her home. Alma was born April 26, 1913 in Browntown, Wisconsin, the daughter of William and Leatha (Peck) Lueck. She graduated from Monroe High School in 1931 and married Herman W. Arn on September 17, 1935 in Evansville.

The couple farmed in Washington Township until moving into Monticello in 1977.

Alma was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and the Friendship Circle. She was a former member of the Washington Homemakers, Monroe Moose Lodge, and was a Washington Center 4-H Sewing Leader. Alma enjoyed traveling, sewing, card playing, baking, and gardening.
