Paul J. Aultman, 94, Former Monticello Resident, Succumbs

Paul J. Aultman, 94 years of age, Cincinnati, Ohio, a former Monticello resident, died Monday afternoon at the Baptist Nursing Center in Cincinnati, where he had been a patient the past four weeks. He had been in good health for one of his age until five weeks ago.

He was born near New Glarus on July 23, 1874, a son of Jost and Susanna Kubly Aultman. He moved with his family as a youth to what is now the Walter Zeller farm, a short distance northeast of Monticello. He was united in marriage on Thanksgiving day, Nov. 27, 1902, in New Glarus, to Anna Hoesly. They lived in New Glarus until moving to Monticello in 1910.

Mr. Aultman was associated with the late S. J. Luchsinger in the implement business here for some time. He later served as superintendent of the Monticello electric light and water utilities, after which he was engaged in the carpenter trade. Mr. and Mrs. Aultman moved to Ohio in 1944 with their son, the Rev. Paul E. Aultman, and had resided in Cincinnati for 20 years.

Mr. Aultman was a 50-year member of the Monticello Masonic lodge, a member of the local Order of the Eastern Star, and the New Glarus Masonic chapter. Mrs. Aultman, who had served as manager of the Monticello telephone exchange for many years, preceded him in death on Dec. 16, 1967. He was also preceded by an infant daughter in 1909.

The son, Rev. Paul Edward Aultman, is the only immediate survivor.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon, Nov. 14, in St. Luke's United Church of Christ in Cincinnati, of which Mr. Aultman's son is pastor. Interment will be in Spring Grove Memorial Mausoleum, Cincinnati.
