

Clarence Babler
March 5, 1902 - December 17, 1991

MONTICELLO — Clarence Babler, age 89, 589 Summit Avenue, Monticello, passed away Tuesday, December 17, 1991, unexpectedly at his home.

He was born in Monticello, Wisconsin, March 5, 1902, the son of Henry and Anna (Losenegger) Babler. He was a graduate of Monticello High School in 1920 and attended the Illinois Pharmacy School in Chicago, becoming a registered pharmacist in 1930. He had worked as a pharmacist in Chicago, Madison and Richland Center, retiring in 1976 in Richland Center. He later made his home in Monroe before moving to Monticello in 1985. He was a veteran of World War II, a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ of Monticello, Amstutz-Party American Legion Post of Monticello and of the Richland Center VFW.

He was the last of his family and is survived by his nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held Saturday, December 21, at 11:00 a.m. at ZWINGLI UNITED CHURCH OF CHRIST in Monticello, with the Reverend Erwin Pegel officiating. Burial and military services will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
