Miss Fannie Babler, Monticello, 77, Dies

Monticello—Miss Fannie Babler, 77, died at the Mrs. Frank Watkins nursing home, Dayton, Sunday evening at 8:30 after several months' illness. Funeral rites will be conducted Wednesday at 2 p. m. in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Interment will be in Highland cemetery.

Fannie Babler, daughter of Ezra and Anna Rhyner Babler, was born in Mt. Pleasant township, May 24, 1868, and attended rural schools. She had always lived around Monticello, during her residence there attending the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.

Only survivors are three sisters, Mrs. Celia Bontly, Monticello, Mrs. Chris Bontly, Madison, and Mrs. Mary Hess, Chehalis, Wash. Several nieces and nephews also survive. Her parents, three brothers and three sisters are deceased.

The body will be at the Voegeli funeral home until noon Wednesday when it will be taken to the church to lie in state till time of the funeral.
