

Marie (Mary) Babler
June 14,1887 - September 5, 1975

Mrs. Marie (Mary) Babler, 88, Monticello passed away at 5:35 a. m. at St. Clare Hospital, Friday. She had been in failing health for about eight weeks and was hospitalized on August 30. Previous to that she was hospitalized in February and July of this year.

Born in Adams township on June 14, 1887, she was the daughter of Fred and Paulina Mathys Kuehni. She was baptized in the New Glarus Swiss United Church of Christ. She attended rural schools in the Verona area. She was married September 14, 1905, in Monticello, to Fred Babler. After their marriage they farmed for 50 years in Mt. Pleasant township on the farm now occupied by the Walter Tryons. She moved to the village of Monticello, August 29, 1963.

Survivors include two daughters, Miss Edna Babler, Monticello, Mrs. Walter (Elva) Tryon, rural, Monticello and a granddaughter, Mary Jean Tryon, Monticello.

She was preceded in death by her husband on January 10, 1965; a daughter, Nona P. Babler, November 7, 1960; her mother in 1895; two brothers Jacob, in 1897; Frederick in 1903; two sisters, Mrs. John (Anna) Von Gonten in 1944, in Racine, and Mrs. Jacob (Lena) Wittwer in 1966, in Belleville, and a half sister, Mrs. Ervin (Dora) Johnson, Barron, Wisconsin in 1963.

She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ. She was confirmed in the Verona Lutheran Church.

In September 1955 they celebrated their golden wedding anniversary in their farm home.

Funeral services were held Sunday, September 7th in Zwingli United Church of Christ at 1:30 p.m. with her pastor, Rev. Charles Workman, officiating. Interment was in Highland Cemetery. Pallbearers were Clarence Blumer, Randall Elmer; Earl Feldt, Dr. C. J. Klooster, Herman Karlen and John Streiff, Jr.

Visitation was Saturday after 6 p. m. in the Memorial Lounge of the church with Voegeli Funeral Service in charge.
