MONTICELLO, WISCONSIN - Willis H. Babler, age 86, died on Saturday, January 20, 1996, at the Monroe Clinic Hospital. He was born in Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, Wisconsin, on October 30, 1909, the son of Henry E. and Rose (Zimmerman) Babler.
