

Fred Baebler
July 3, 1906 - July 2, 1977

Area relatives have received word of the death of Fred Baebler, 70, of International Falls, Minn. He died in the Falls Memorial Hospital on Saturday, July 2.

The son of Vinzenz and Elizabeth Baebler, he was born in Mt. Pleasant Township on July 3, 1906. He attended school in the township and on Jan. 22, 1928, he and Eva Jones were married at Langfor, South Dakota. They lived in S. D. several years, and then moved to Monticello, where they lived until he was inducted into the U. S. Army in WW 2. He was in the Army three years, part of which was served in the European theater. After his discharge, he and his wife moved to Janesville, where he worked for 16 years for General Motors. In 1973, they moved to International Falls, Minn., where they have been residing since.

He is survived by his wife, Eva, a former school teacher in the Monticello area; two sisters, Mrs. Frieda Pickett, Monroe, and Mrs. Louise Hahn, Arlington; two brothers, Herman, Redwood City, Calif., and Alvin, Monticello.

He was preceded in death by his parents and a brother, John.

His funeral was held on Wednesday, July 6, in the Green-Larsen Memorial Chapel in International Falls, with the Rev. Rolph Wangberg officiating. Graveside interment rites were held on Friday, July 8, in the Britton Cemetery, South Dakota.
