Mrs. Bandi, 82, Succumbs Here

Mrs. Bertha Bandi, 82, of 1914. 7th avenue, died at 9:55 p. m. Saturday at St. Clare hospital. Old age complications were fatal. She entered the hospital April 5.

The former Bertha Hahn, daughter of John and Matilda Brown Hahn, Mrs. Bandi was born Nov. 8, 1877. She and Alexander Bandi were married Aug. 13, 1896, in St. John's church. Mr. Bandi died in April, 1932.
