Mrs. Mary Bandi, 65, Mt. Pleasant Native, Dies; Services today

Mrs. Mary Bandi, 65 years of age, New Glarus, died Monday at 12:45 noon at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since Saturday evening.

Born in Mt. Pleasant township on Dec. 19, 1895, she was the daughter of Fred C. and Susanna Zentner Elmer. She attended rural schools. On Feb 20, 1919 she was united in marriage to Charles F. Bandi, the ceremony taking place in Belleville. They farmed in Primrose township, Dane county, and retired to New Glarus, July 12, 1948.

Mrs. Bandi was a member of the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus and its Ladies Aid society, taking a keen interest in both.

Mrs. Bandi is survived by her mother, one daughter, Mrs. Russell Fjelstad, Belleville, and a grandson.

She was preceded in death by her husband on April 13, 1952, her father June 20, 1934, a brother Fred C. Elmer Jr., Dec. 5, 1958.

Funeral services will be held at 2 this (Thursday) afternoon in the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus. The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, will officiate. Burial will be in Highland cemetery, Monticello.
