

Fay M. Bartlett

Jan. 11, 1892 - March 2, 1971

Mrs. C. Romayn (Fay M.) Bartlett, 79, Albany, died Tuesday morning, March 2, after a long illness.

The former Fay Knapp was born on Jan. 11, 1892, in Wilson, Kans., the daughter of E. Q. and Alice Ramsey Knapp. Her parents ran the post office and general store in Attica for several years.

In 1912 she and C. Romayn Bartlett were married in Attica. They farmed in that vicinity until retiring to Albany in 1954. The couple observed their golden wedding anniversary in 1962. Mr. Bartlett died on Oct. 1, 1962.

Mrs. Bartlett was a former member of the Attica Methodist Church and the Ladies Aid Society and a charter member of the Attica Homemakers Club.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Edward (Arlene) Oliver, and Mrs Virginia Blumer, both of Albany; and Mrs. Loren (Cynthia) Bagley, Beloit; one brother, Clyde Knapp, Chicago; 12 grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.

Preceding her in death were her husband; her grandson, Kris Blumer, on June 25, 1969, and two brothers, Leon and Winfred.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday, March 5, in Gohlke-Sharer Funeral Home, Albany. Rev. Charles A. Fox. will officiate. Burial will be in Attica Cemetery.
