

**Homer T. Bartlett**  
**May 16, 1918 – Sept. 28, 1967**  
**H. T. Bartlett Taken by Death**

Homer T. Bartlett, 49, Benson, Minn., whose parents were natives of Albany and Brooklyn Townships, died Thursday evening in a Minnesota hospital following a long illness. Complications followed surgery performed on Aug. 17.

He was born May 16, 1918, in Danvers, Minn., the son of Percy J. and Myrta Norton Bartlett, and was married in 1947 to Patricia Burrington, the wedding taking place in the East.

They farmed on the Bartlett farm home near Danvers for a time and for the past 15 years had lived at Benson where he was employed at the Kokken Company, maker of wagons.

He is survived by his wife, his father, three sisters, Mrs. Herbert Striker, Albany; Mrs. Stanley Eggerstrom, Kerkhoven, Minn., and Mrs. Leona Bowers, who is on the home place with her father and two brothers, Lyle, also at home, and Percy Jr., of Danvers. His mother is deceased.

A mass will be held Monday morning at the Church of Visitation there and a later service will be held at the Sharer Funeral Home, Albany, where arrangements are pending.
