## Alice Clara Beck March 16, 1911 - June 4, 1987

Mrs. Alice Clara Beck, 76, Monticello died Thursday, June 4, 1987, at her residence.

She was a member of the Friendship Circle of Zwingli United Church of Christ, American Legion Auxiliary and the Order of Eastern Star.
