Mrs. Emil Blum Succumbs at 77

MONTICELLO (Times Special) — Mrs. Emil Blum, 77, a resident of Monticello for 52 years, died at 11:30 a.m. yesterday at her home here. She had been ill a long time.

Services will be at 2 p.m. tomorrow in the Voegeli funeral home where friends may call. Rev. J. Allan Mittler of Zwingli United Church of Christ will officiate, with burial in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers will be Harold Albertson, Carl Duerst and Gene Webber, all of New Glarus; Doran Blum and John Zweifel, both of Monroe, and Mel Puttkamer, Madison.

Mrs. Blum was the former Margaret Marty, daughter of Fred and Louisa Deitz Marty. She was born Nov. 14, 1882 in Chicago. She and Emil Blum were married in Monroe on, Jan. 15, 1904. Mrs. Blum had lived in New Glarus and Dayton before coming to Monticello and had attended New Glarus schools.

Surviving are a son, Ray E. Blum, and a daughter, Miss Margaret Blum, both of Monticello; a brother, Roy Marty, St. Paul, Minn.; a sister, Mrs. Fan Kalber, Chicago, four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Sept. 13, 1946; a daughter, Dolores, in 1955; a son, Lawrence in 1956 and two grandchildren. Her late husband was school janitor for 11 years before his death.
