Peter Blum, 82, Area Native, Dies Sunday

Funeral services for Peter Blum, 82 years of age, resident of Monticello for many years, who passed away at 6:10 Sunday morning at the home of a niece, Mrs. Alvin Baebler, Monroe street, were held at 2 Tuesday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were John L. Altman, Wilbert J. Dick, James F. Dooley, Herman Gempeler, Morgan Phillips, and M. R. Zimmerman. Mr. Blum had been in failing health for some time, but died unexpectedly of an apparent sudden heart attack.
