

Andrew Bontly
Feb. 15, 1858 - Sept. 11, 1940

MONROE—Andrew Bontly, 82, retired Monticello farmer, father of Edward and Wilbert Bontly, Madison, died here Wednesday at St. Clare hospital after a brief illness.

He was born in Nashville, Tenn., Feb. 15, 1858, the son of Mr. and Mrs. John Bontly. They moved to Washington township, Green county, in 1867. He married Mary Baebler in Monroe Sept. 20, 1883. They lived on a Washington township farm until moving to Monticello in 1908. Mrs. Bontly died Feb. 22, 1934. Mr. Bontly was a member of the Monticello Reformed church.

Surviving, besides his two sons, are a daughter, Mrs. R. A. Bast, Grand Forks, N. D., and a brother, Christ, Madison.

The body was taken to the Voegeli funeral home in Monticello.
