Hans Brusveen, Age 94, York Township, Dies; Rites Saturday

Funeral services for Hans Brusveen, 94 years of age, native of Norway and retired York township farmer, who died at 11:45 a.m. on Wednesday of last week at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, were held at 1:30 Saturday afternoon in the York Memorial Lutheran church.

The Rev. Joseph R. Hestenes officiated and burial was in the York Memorial cemetery.

Mr. Brusveen's death came as a result of a prolonged illness resulting from old age complications.

He was born in Torpin, Valders, Norway, on March 9, 1876, the son of Haldor and Marit Venden Brusveen. The family came to America in 1884 and settled in York township. He was united in marriage on Dec. 31, 1907, to Bertha Erickson at the Erickson homestead. The couple always farmed in York township. Mr. and Mrs. Brusveen observed their 60th wedding anniversary in 1947. Mrs. Brusveen died Nov. 20, 1968.

Mr. Brusveen was a life member of the York Memorial Lutheran church.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Mabel Jorenby, Blanchardville, and Mrs. Byron (Dora) Kittleson, Mt. Horeb; two sons, Thomas, Monticello, and Howard, Route 1, Blanchardville, with whom the late Mr. and Mrs. Brusveen had made their home; six grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.

The last of his family, Mr. Brusveen was preceded in death by three brothers and a sister and his parents.
