J. Herbert Burgy Dies

MONTICELLO - J. Herbert Burgy, 74, a retired professor, died Monday, Dec. 11, 1972, in a Monroe nursing home after a heart attack.

He was born in Washington Township. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees from the University of Wisconsin, and his doctor's degree in economic geography from Clarke University, Worcester, Massachusetts.

He taught at Culver Military Academy, Culver, Indiana; the University of Minnesota; Bradley University, Peoria, Illinois; Salem State College, Salem, Mass.; Hunter College, New York City, and Los Angeles State University.

He also taught in military schools in Europe during World War II.

Surviving in Madison is a sister, Mrs. H. C. Hoesly, 9 S. Spooner St. Also surviving is a brother, Fred "P.", Monticello.

The funeral will be at 1:30 p.m. Thursday in the Zwingli United Church of Christ. There will be no visitation. A memorial fund has been established in Mr. Burgy's name.
