## Louisa Elizabeth Burgy

1875 - Nov. 19, 1941

Mrs. Jacob J. Burgy, 68, Monticello resident died Thursday evening the Monroe Hospital, where she had been a patient only a day. She had been suffering from heart disease for a long time.
