### **Miss Kate Butler, Albany**

Albany — Miss Kate Butler, 59, many years a school teacher in Green county and for 20 years a resident of Albany, died at the home of her sister, Mrs. John Keefe, Monticello, Wednesday. Death was due to anemia.

Miss Butler was born In Mount Pleasant, Green county, Dec. 2, 1864, and in 1870 moved to Brooklyn, where her father died in 1872. In 1905, she moved to Albany with her mother, and resided there until last December when she went to Monticello to live with her sister. Her mother died in 1916. Two sisters preceded her in death.

Surviving are a brother, Thomas, of Albany, and three sisters, Mrs. John Martin, Adell, Ia., Mrs, Mike Keefe, Footville, and Mrs. John Keefe, Monticello.

Funeral service's will be held in the Albany Catholic church at 10 a, m. Saturday. Burial will be in the local cemetery.
