Mt. Pleasant Twp. Resident Succumbs Miss Catherine Carroll, 75, Dies in Monroe; Last Rites Held

Miss Catherine Carroll, 75 years of age, life long resident of Mt. Pleasant township, passed away Sunday night in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since fracturing her hip Thursday morning.

Miss Carroll, who had been in failing health for the past number of months, had been a patient in the hospital for a number of weeks last fall. Upon her dismissal from the institution she came to Monticello and had since been cared for at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Lawrence Blum. Early Thursday morning she fell, sustaining a fractured hip. Death was caused by complications.

Miss Carroll was born March 10, 1867, in Mt. Pleasant township, the daughter of Anthony and Bridget Cary Carroll. She attended the Zentner rural school and the Monroe high school. For a time she taught rural school. She had always lived on the Carroll homestead farm,

Nieces and nephews are the only survivors, She was preceded in death by four brothers, Anthony F., William, John, and Dennis, and two sister, Mary Ann and Alice.

Last rites will be conducted at at 10:30 this (Thursday) morning in St. James Catholic church, Dayton, of which she was a member. Rev. Leo Zingsheim, pastor will officiate, and burial will be in the Dayton Catholic cemetery.

The Rosary, scheduled to be recited Wednesday evening at the Voegeli funeral home, was not held because of road conditions, but will be recited following mass Sunday morning.
