

Stanley Donovan Chandler Jr.

Don Chandler, age 51, of Monticello, died on Saturday, May 9, 1981, at the V. A. Hospital, Madison.

He was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Donovan Chandler, Sr. He was a graduate of the Madison East High School in 1947. He was a former resident of Madison and Cottage Grove, moving to Monticello in 1978.
