### **Mrs. Frank G. Clark, 55, Dies Suddenly**

Funeral services for Mrs. Frank G. Clark, 55 years of age, former Monticello resident, who passed away at 11 a. m. Thursday at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, were held at 2 Sunday afternoon at the Voeggli funeral home here.

The Rev. Paul J. Gibson, pastor of the Bethel EUB church, Brodhead, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery here. Pallbearers were Gary Brewer, Stanley Johnson, Albany, Jacob O. Buol, Jr., Fred Crooks, Belleville, Robert Derendinger, Brodhead, and Monty Chesebro, Monticello.

Mrs. Clark died suddenly and unexpectedly after being ill only a few hours.

Frieda E. Marty was born in Monroe township, March 18, 1906, the daughter of Christ H. and Anna Brechlien Marty. She attended the Round Grove rural school and graduated from the Monroe high school in 1923. On April 11, 1925, she was united in marriage to Frank G. Clark, the ceremony taking place in Monroe. They lived in Monticello for 20 years, where Mr. Clark served as a rural mail carrier. In 1943 they moved to a farm in Exeter township and in 1957 to a farm northeast of Albany. Two months ago they moved to a small place in Decatur township, between Albany and Brodhead.

Mrs. Clark was a member of the Royal Neighbors lodge and of the Evangelical United Brethren church while she resided in Monticello.

She is survived by two brothers; LeRoy and Alvin W. Marti, Monroe, and four sisters, Mrs. Sanford V. Smith, Sr. Jamestown, N. Y., Mrs. Thomas Cotheman, Monticello, Mrs. Cecil Holloway and Miss Mildred Marti, Route 4, Monroe. She was preceded in death by her parents and one sister in infancy.
