Dr. B. L. Clarke, 83 Dies, Rites Held

He practiced his profession in Monticello for 51 years, retiring in 1946. A pleasant, friendly individual, "Doc" was always admired and respected by his many friends throughout the community. A credit to his profession, Dr. Clarke was always held in the highest regard by other members of the veterinary field.

Dr. Clarke was a member and honorary president of the Wisconsin Veterinarians Association, and a member of the American Veterinarian Association.
