Rites Held Saturday For Susie Cotherman Clarno Twp. Resident Dies At Pierce Home Here Thursday Night

Funeral services for Miss Susie Cotherman, 78 years of age, Clarno township, who passed away Thursday evening at the home of her sister, Mrs. Frank Pierce, at the south edge of Monticello, following several months of failing health, were conducted at 2 Saturday afternoon in the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. W. J. Abe, pastor of Grace Evangelical church, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery.

Susie Cotherman was born in Monroe township Nov. 2, 1866, the daughter of Thomas and Susan Ball Cotherman. She graduated from the Monroe high school and was engaged as a rural school teacher for many years. She taught at Monticello until 1903, when she discontinued her vocation to assist her parents on the homestead farm in Monroe township. After the death of her parents in 1920, she purchased a small farm in Clarno township. She resided on the farm during the summer but had spent the winter months of the past 10 years with her sister, Mrs. Pierce.

Survivors are a brother, Ernest Cotherman, Washington township, and two sisters, Mrs. Frank Pierce, Monticello, and Mrs. John Geigel, Monroe.

Miss Cotherman was a former member of the Advent Christian church,
