### **William Crawford, Exeter, Succumbs**

William Crawford, 87, Exeter Township, died early last night in a Green County hospital after a five weeks illness. He had entered the hospital Thursday.

A native of Belfast, Ireland, Mr. Crawford was born Nov. 11, 1868. He came to America with his wife and two children 40 years ago and spent two years in Chicago before settling in Albany.

Mr. Crawford had worked in the linen mills in Ireland, and he was first employed in Albany in the old linen mill. For 20 years he operated a restaurant and meat market before retiring with his wife to St. Petersburg, Fla., for 14 years. Three years ago they returned to 'this area and have lived with their son, Eugene, Exeter Township.

Survivors include his wife and a son, Eugene. A daughter, Dorothy, preceded him in death.

Services will be held at 2 p. m. tomorrow in the Sharer funeral home, Albany. Rev. Bruce Willett, student pastor of the Methodist Church, will officiate. Burial will be in Hillcrest cemetery.
