

Mary Ann Crompton
March 12, 1827 - June 13, 1914

Mary Ann Miley was born March 12, 1827, in county Ross Common, Ireland. At the age of thirteen years she came to America and settled in Dayton, Ohio, where she was married to Thomas Crompton March 8, 1852. They came to Wisconsin in 1855, To this union was born four sons and four daughters, all living but one son who died in infancy. Her husband preceded her in death November 23, 1910. After her husband's death she made her home with her daughter, Mrs. J. H. Loughead.

She passed away June 13, 1914, at the age of eighty-seven years, three months and one day.

She leaves to mourn her: One sister, Katherine Featherstone. Four daughters -Mrs. S. McKinney, Fitchburg; Mrs. Cyrus Crabtree, Madison; Mrs. P. H. Root, Brooklyn; Mrs. J. H. Loughead, Belleville. Three sons—Thomas of Wetonka, S. D., Charles and Robert of Brodhead. Also thirty-two grand-children and thirty-three great-grand-children.

The funeral was held Tuesday afternoon at one o'clock, at the residence of J. H. Loughead. Rev. H. W. Ewart officiated, assisted by Rev. G. S. Joslin. Interment was in the Attica cemetery.
