

Sam H. Crooks

May 15, 1915 - May 14, 1995

MONTICELLO — Sam H. Crooks age 79, passed away Sunday, May 14, 1995, at the Monroe Manor Nursing Home where he has been a patient since 1991. He was born in Moscow township near Blanchardville, Wisconsin, May 15, 1915, the son of Samuel and Mathilda (Kumm) Crooks Sr.

He was married April 9, 1941 to Alice Zweifel in Belleville, Wisconsin and she preceded him in death on February 4, 1972. He later married Viola Miller Bandi on March 4, 1979.

Sam farmed in the Monroe, Brodhead and Monticello areas until he retired to Monroe in 1979 and made Monroe his home prior to entering the nursing home.

He is survived by two sons, Edward (Evelyn) Crooks and George (Jeanette) Crooks both of rural Brodhead; four grandchildren; and four great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents; five brothers; and four sisters.
