

Anna Crouch

August 28, 1888 - June 6, 1975

Mrs. Anna Crouch, 86, died in Pleasant View Nursing Home, rural Monroe, on Friday, June 6, after a long illness. She had lived in Washington Township for many years and had been a resident at Pleasant View since 1973.

She was born August 28, 1888, the daughter of John and Armeritta Duerst Disch. She attended rural schools, and on April 2, 1907, she was married to Josiah Crouch. They spent their entire married life in Washington Township. He died in 1947, and she continued to live there with a son and daughter-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Josiah Crouch, Jr.,

Survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Ernest (Lorraine) Brunner, Monroe; two sons, Albert, and Josiah, Jr., both of Monticello; six grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren. She was the last of her family. She was preceded in death by a sister, Mrs. Jacob Elmer, and five brothers, John, Henry, Fred, Jacob, and Christ.

Funeral services were held Monday, June 9, in the Washington Reformation Church, of which she was a member. Her pastor, Rev. Duane McDonough, officiated and burial was in Greenwood Cemetery, Monroe.
