

Nathan A. Crouch

Nathan Crouch Taken by Death

Nathan A. Crouch, 55, of 718 11th St., custodian at the Green County Teachers College since 1952, died at 1:13 this morning in St. Clare Hospital. He had entered there as a medical patient on April 12 after several months illness.

Mr. Crouch was born July 25, 1909 in Monroe, the son of Arthur E. and Genevieve Elmer Crouch. He attended schools in Washington Township and graduated from Monroe High School in 1927. He attended Ripon College for a year. On Nov. 30, 1935 he was married in Monticello to Clara A. Zentner.

They first farmed on the Washington Township home farm and then in the Monticello-Albany area.

Mr. Crouch was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ and its Brotherhood and was a CD auxiliary police.

Surviving are his wife; three daughters, Mrs. Clarence (Patricia) Pluss, rural Albany: Jane, Lake Geneva, and Mary, at home and a junior in Monroe High School, and a sister, Mrs. Carl A. Miller, Monroe. His father died March 23, 1926 and his mother, Jan. 23, 1940.

Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in St. John's Church. Rev. Calvin P. Fischer and Rev. Donald Storck will officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery at Monticello.
