

Mabel Daubert

Aug. 12, 1916 – October 28, 1979

Funeral services were held Wednesday, Oct. 31, for Mrs. John (Mabel) Daubert, 63, Monroe, who died Sunday, Oct. 28, in St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient for the past week.

She was born in Mt. Pleasant township on Aug. 12, 1916, the daughter of Jake and Livona Pierce Schultz. She attended the Zentner rural school in Mt. Pleasant Township and Monticello High School.

On Dec. 15, 1937, she was married to John Daubert in St. John's United Church of Christ, of Monroe. They had celebrated their 40th wedding anniversary in 1977. They retired to Monroe in 1965 after farming in Mt. Pleasant Township for many years.

She had been employed for the past four years as a caterer for the Monroe Clinic. She attended St. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe, and was a member of the Mt. Pleasant Homemakers Club.

Services were held in the Newcomer Funeral Home, Monroe. Rev. W. C. Koehler of St. John's Church officiated and burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include her husband, John; a daughter, Mrs. Richard (Janice) Burkhalter, rural Juda; a son, Armin, rural Monticello; 5 grandchildren and a brother, Raymond Schultz, New Haven, Ind.

Preceding her in death was her father on Dec. 17, 1964, and her mother, May 1, 1964.
