F. Earl Deininger, 62, Succumbs Monday

F. Earl Deininger, 62 years of age, a resident of Monticello at one time, died Monday in Albuquerque, N. M.,

Funeral services were to be held at 10 a. m. today (Thursday) in Albuquerque. Burial will be at 1:30 p. m. in the Arlington National cemetery at Santa Fe, N. M.

He was born at Blanchardville, the son of the late Carl (Charles) and Louise Caroline Regez Deininger. He graduated from the Monticello high school. For some years before entering the army in World War II he was employed by the Kraft Cheese Co. as a salesman. He had previously been employed as a route man by a Wisconsin bakery.

Since 1945 he was in charge of the food procurement division at the Veterans Administration hospital in Albuquerque.

Mr. Deininger visited in this area for several weeks last summer.

Surviving are his wife, Marie; two sons of a former marriage, Gary, Evansville, and Jack, Fond du Lac; and two sisters, Mrs. Lawrence Harold, Belleville, and Mrs. O. F. Champion, Rockford, Ill.
