John Dick, Monticello, Rites Set for Wednesday

Monticello- Funeral services for John Dick, 83, Monticello, former banker and Green County board member, will be held at 2:00 PM Wednesday in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed Church.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier will officiate. Burial will be in the Highland Cemetery.

Mr. Dick died on Monday at his home after a long illness. The body will be at the Voegeli Funeral Home from 10:00 AM today until noon Wednesday.

He was born in Washington Township and was married November 15, 1894, to Anna Messerli. They farmed until 1903, when they moved to Monticello, where he was associated with the People's Supply Co. for 31 years.

Mr. Dick was a member of the Green County board from 1899 to 1914 and served on the Green County farm and poor commissions for 23 years, then on the old age pension committee for three years.

He was a member of the consistory of the Zwingli church for 40 years and its president for 30 years before he became honorary president.

He was a member of the school board and its president for several years. He was a director of the Bank of Monticello and its vice president from 1941 until he retired in 1947.

Survivors include his wife; three sons Wilbert, Waldo, and Carl, and two daughters Mrs. C. W. Karlen and Lora Dick all of Monticello; four sisters Mrs. Rose Wittwer, Mrs. Louise Staedtler, and Mrs. Anna Klossner, all of Madison and Mrs. Minnie Marty, Los Angeles CA; four grandchildren and one great grandchild.
