

## **ROY F. DICKSON**

**November 24, 1910 – May 16, 2001**

Roy F. Dickson, age 90, passed away on May 16, 2001 at his home in Monticello. He was born on November 24, 1910, to William and Ida (Pinnow) Dickson in rural Spring Grove Township. On May 15, 1936, Roy married Anne Schild at the Immanuel Evangelical Church in Monroe.

Roy entered the United States Navy in January 1944.
