Chris Disch, Aged 78, Dies Early Monday; Final Services Held

Funeral services for Chris Disch, 78 years of age, native of Switzerland and resident of the Monticello area since he was a small child, who passed away at 9:45 a. m. Monday in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, were held at 2 Wednesday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home.

The Rev. J. Allan Mittler, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, officiated, and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Albert Crouch, Josiah Crouch, Jr., Frederick C. Disch, Gilbert Disch, Karl F. Disch, Monticello, and Fred W. Disch, Verona.

Mr. Disch had been hospitalized since Saturday evening, at which time he became suddenly ill.

He was born in Switzerland on Aug. 26, 1883, the son of John and Amerita Zuerst Disch. At the age of one year he accompanied his family to America, settling in Green county. For some time he farmed in the Albany area and in later years was employed on farms in the Monticello vicinity. For the past two years he had made his home with a nephew, Willis Disch, and family, here in Monticello.

Mr. Disch was member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

He is survive by one sister, Mrs. Anna Crouch, Monticello, and nieces and nephews.

Mr. Disch was preceded in death by four brothers, John, C. Fred, Henry and Jacob S., and one sister, Mrs. Jacob Elmer.
