

Ilene V. Disch

October 24, 1919 - June 12, 1989

Mrs. Willis J. (Ilene) V. Disch, 69, 205 4th Ave., Monroe, formerly a long time Monticello resident, died Monday, June 12, 1989 at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe.

She was born on October 24, 1919 in Greenwood, (Clark County) Wisconsin, and her parents were Roy C. and Percis C. (Haesfner) Vine. She attended rural schools at Clark County and Monticello High School.

She married Willis John Disch, at Monticello, on November 15, 1938. Following their marriage they farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township until 1953 when they moved to Monticello. She worked at Oaktron Industries, Monroe, until 1970 when she retired. The past 10 years they have spent the winters in Florida. They moved to Monroe in 1988.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

Survivors include her husband; one son, Harvey W. Disch, rural Albany; two daughters, Mrs. Darien (Pauline J.) Gates, Edmond, Okla. and Mrs. Dennis (Alberta I.) Truttman, Monticello; and a half-brother, Bernard Vine, Albany, and 10 grandchildren.

They celebrated their 50 anniversary on November 15, 1988.

Preceded in death by her mother in 1953 and her father in 1987.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, June 16 at 1:30 p.m. at the Zwingli United Church of Christ. Rev. Erwin Pegel will officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
