On Dec. 9, 1909, he. was united in marriage to Della Mae Staley. They farmed one and one-half miles east of Monticello until retiring in 1944, when they moved to the village to make their home.

Mr. Disch was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church. He served as treasurer of the Zentner school district for many years,

Surviving are his. wife: one son, Willis, Monticello, one daughter, Mrs. LeRoy Vine, Evansville; one brother, Chris Monticello; one sister, Mrs. Anna Crouch, Monticello; and six grandchildren.
