

Barbara Disch-Streiff
Sept. 26, 1889 - Sept. 27, 1992

Barbara Disch-Streiff, 103, died Sunday, Sept. 27, 1992 at the Oregon Nursing Home.

She was born on Sept. 26, 1889, in Monticello, to Leonard and Marcia (Rhyner) Altmann. Barbara married Henry L. Disch on February 26, 1906, in Monticello. They moved to Verona and farmed until Henry died on June 14, 1943. On April 12, 1951, she married Fred Streiff and resided in New Glarus, where they owned and operated the Swiss Motel and Restaurant and the Chevy Garage. Fred preceded her in death on Oct. 8, 1957. She was 82 years old when she retired.

Survivors include three sons, Fred "Frick" (Bernice) Disch, Madison, Gilbert (Rose) Disch, Monticello, and Clarence (Betty) Disch, Oregon; a daughter, Louise Zuber, New Glarus; 18 grandchildren; 50 great-grandchildren; 23 great-great-grandchildren; and a great-great-great-grandchild. She was preceded in death by a son, Herman; a brother, John Altmann; a special friend, Paul Lechmen; two daughters-in-law, Lilly and Marybell; a son-in-law, John Zuber; two grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the People's United Methodist Church in Oregon on Wednesday, Sept. 30, with Pastor Howard Hintzman officiating. Burial was at Verona Cemetery.
