December 4, 1912 - March 4, 1983

Funeral services were held for David G. Dooley, 70, Rt. 1, Beloit, on Monday, March 7 at 1 p.m. at the Hanson Funeral Home, Beloit. Mr. Dooley died Friday, March 4 at Beloit Memorial Hospital.
