

Lucian Edwards

Sept. 22, 1894 - Aug. 14, 1974

A Monticello native, Lucian Edwards, 79, Janesville, died early Wednesday morning, Aug. 14, in the VA Hospital, Madison.

He was born Sept. 22, 1894, a son of Albert and Minnie Pratt Edwards, and was a veteran of World War I, serving in France. He was a retired rural mail carrier out of Madison and later had worked at Lake Lawn in Delavan. He had lived in Janesville since 1960. His father was one-time Monticello postmaster.

Mr. Edwards was a member of the VFW and Veterans of World War I.

Surviving are his widow, the former Hattie Sims, whom he married May 17, 1954; a son, Robert Edwards, Crystal Lake, Ill., by a former marriage; three brothers, Harry at Albany; Roy, Philadelphia, Pa., and Wayne, Lebanon, Pa.; eight grandchildren, and three stepchildren, Gerald Sims and Mrs. Robert Laskowski, both of Decatur, Ill., and Mrs. James Meyers, Manitou Springs, Colo.

He was preceded in death by a brother, a sister and his parents.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday, Aug. 16 in Wolfgram Funeral Home, Janesville. Burial is to be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello, about 2:45 p.m.
