Ray Edwards, Age 64, Dies Suddenly

Ray Edwards, 64 years of age, a native of Monticello, died of a heart attack at about 3 p. m. last Thursday while playing golf at Philadelphia, Pa.

Mr. and Mrs. Edwards had spent the months of June and July in Wisconsin. Mr. Edwards was a certified public accountant and for the past 35 years had done the accounting for Hoard's Dairyman at Ft. Atkinson.

He was the son of Albert and Minnie Pratt Edwards. His father, who died Nov. 1, 1937, was a former postmaster in Monticello. His mother died in November, 1944. They had retired to Madison after leaving Monticello.

Surviving are his wife; a son and daughter in the Philadelphia area; and four brothers, Harry, Albany, Lucian, Delavan, and Roy and Wayne, both of Philadelphia. Roy is a twin brother of the deceased.

Funeral services for Mr. Edwards were held at 2 p. m. Monday in Ardmore, Pa. Burial was also there in West Laurel Hill cemetery, Bala Cynwyd, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania.
