June 4, 1890 - January 1959
Mrs. Feenje Stricken at 68

MONTICELLO — Mrs. Hilda Feenje, 68, Monticello, died at 8:15 this morning in her home after a long illness.

Mrs. Feenje, the former Hilda Rolph, was born June 4, 1890, the daughter of Charles F. and Rosa Fichter Rolph. She attended Monticello high school and Monroe Business College. She was a bookkeeper and florist.

She was married Nov. 18, 1920, at Monticello to Herman W. Feenje, native of Holland who died May 1, 1949.

The only immediate survivor is a sister, Mrs. Fred Stauffer. The Stauffers resided with Mrs. Feenje. A brother, Charles M. Rolph, preceded her in death.

Mrs. Feenje was a member of Monticello EUB church and its Aid Society and the Postville Memorial chapel and was treasurer of the Postville and EUB Sunday schools.
