### **August Feldt, 94, Mt. Pleasant Native, Dies**

Funeral services for August Feldt, 94 years of age, a former Mt. Pleasant township resident, who died at 9:30 p.m. Thursday in Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe, were held at 3 Sunday afternoon in the Stuessy Funeral Home.

The Rev. Melvin J. Roehrdanz of the Immanuel church, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

Mr. Feldt died of old age complications. Both he and his wife had been residents at Pleasant View for over two years.

Mr. Feldt was born Jan. 7, 1875, in Mt. Pleasant township, the son of August and Minnie Brandt Feldt. He attended rural schools. On Feb. 13, 1901, he was united in marriage to Amelia Schutt. They farmed in Mt. Pleasant township, then moved to Monroe in 1920, where they lived for three years, after which they returned to their farm and remained there until 1940.

Mr. Feldt was a member of the Immanuel United Methodist church of Monroe.

Surviving are the widow: two foster daughters, Mrs. Paul Frederick, Albany, and Mrs. William Crawford, Hanover, Ill.: two grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; a foster grandchild, and two foster great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Fred (Stella) Abbott, an only daughter, died March 31, 1965. Mr. Feldt was the last of his family. He was preceded in death by four brothers, Frank, Ed, John and Fred, and two sisters, Mrs. Emma Luchsinger and Mrs. Herman Ladwig.
