Mrs. August Feldt, 78, Monroe, Expires
Long Illness Proves Fatal To Well Known Monroe Lady; Rites Held

Monroe—Mrs, August Feldt, 78, of 523 17th avenue, Monroe, died at her home on Wednesday morning of last week after a long illness.

The former Minnie Miltz was born in Piertiz, Germany, and came to Monroe in 1893. She was married that year to August Feldt at Juda, and they lived on a farm in Sylvester township until moving to Monroe 23 years ago. He died in 1934.

Survivors include two sons, Otto and Harry, Sylvester township; five daughters, Mrs. Tobias Wild and Mrs. Herman Wild, both of Jefferson township, Mrs. Minnie Chryst, Monroe, Mrs, Carl Siedschlag, Clarno township, and Mrs. Fred Karlen, Jr.. Adams township; 25 grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren.
