Roy A. Feldt, 89, a resident of the New Glarus Home apartments, died Sunday, Nov. 15, 1992.

He was born on July 18, 1903 in Green County, the son of Frank and Martha (Byers) Feldt. He was a graduate of Monticello High School in 1922 and was married on June 23, 1927 to Elsie Budde, in Freeport. He worked at the condensery in Middleton and then in 1925 became a mailman in the city of Monroe until 1949 when he was a rural mail carrier for the Monticello area, retiring in 1968. In 1985 he moved to the New Glarus Home Apartments.

Survivors include a son, Alvin, Forest Lake, Minn.; and a daughter, Mrs. Karen (Richard) Christman, Duluth, Minn.; four grandchildren; four great-grandchildren and one sister, Mrs. Pearl (Ray) Van Sickle, Jupiter, Fla.

Preceding him in death were his parents, his wife Elsie, Jan. 5, 1987, and two brothers, Bill and Earl.

Services were held Wednesday, at the United Methodist Church, Monroe, with Rev. Anthony Farino officiating. Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery, Monroe.
