

## **Alonzo Fenton**

**March 14, 1817 - December 22, 1896**

Alonzo was born on March 14, 1817 in the town of Preston, Chenango County, N.Y. the son of Washington and Sally (Mead) Fenton. He married Mary Ann Whipple in July of 1838. She was born December 15, 1821 in Cattaraugus Co., N.Y.; the daughter of Phillip and Sally (Chappell) Whipple. The couple came to Wisconsin in 1845 with 3 of their children, the 4<sup>th</sup> being born soon after their arrival. The family settled on a farm about 1.5 miles east of Attica.

Alonzo and Mary Ann became the parents of 10 children, 7 surviving to adulthood. Mary Ann died on March 3, 1894 and Alonzo died on December 22, 1896.
