

## **Marcella J. Fiedler**

**May 4, 1910 - January 2, 1999**

Marcella J, Fiedler age 88, of Stoughton, formerly of Monticello, died Saturday, January 2, 1999 at Stoughton Hospital following a brief illness. Marcella was born May 4, 1910 in Dane County, the daughter of the late Bennie and Bertha (Peterson) Newburg. She attended school in Vienna Township, Dane County and later attended Vocational School in Madison. She married Clarence Fiedler on September 12, 1929 in Madison. He preceded her in death on July 2, 1975. Following her marriage, Marcella and her husband farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, from 1941 until 1975. She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and the Stoughton Senior Center.

Survivors include a daughter, Dolores (Roy) Mauerman, Brodhead; a son, William C. (Charlene) Fiedler, Stoughton; six grandchildren and nineteen great-grandchildren.

In addition to her husband she was preceded in death by her parents; two granddaughters, Janet Huffman on July 18, 1978 and Julie Hulbert on September 9, 1997; three brothers, Burt, Perry, and Artman Newburg; a sister, Rosie Newburg; six half-brothers and two half-sisters.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, January 5, 1999, at the Voegeli-Newcomer Funeral Home, Monticello, with Rev. Lawrence Balleine of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, officiating with interment in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
